Route to Fruithuisje 39 – from July 1, 2024

Due to the massive amount of through traffic trying to avoid the A2/A27 junction heading south, the Municipality of Vijfheerenlanden has implemented a restrictive measure during the evening rush hour. This means that from Monday to Friday, between 3:00 PM and 7:00 PM, Achthoven is not accessible from the Lexmond side for vehicles not originating from the municipality. You would then need to detour via the A27 – exit Meerkerk. Enforcement is done by a fixed camera.


It may seem inconvenient and troublesome, but the effect is that the dyke is much calmer and safer. Fortunately, there is an exception for business owners and guests of the B&B. Therefore, there is a QR code with a confirmation code in the house, allowing you to request a day permit on the same day.

To ensure that you can also approach the holiday home via the normal route, please pay attention to the following route description below. The change has been implemented in Google Maps as well as in some other navigation systems. In Google, even 24/7, so also outside of rush hours. Below is an image of the route from Google Maps that you should not take. The second image shows a route in Here Maps, which you can take with a day permit.

The shortened route description is as follows: take exit Vianen from the A2 and follow the Bentz-Berg towards Lexmond. In the left-hand bend, take the provincial road to the right towards Lexmond and Meerkerk. After a few kilometers, take the Lexmond exit and immediately turn left into the village. At the end of the road, turn right at the T-junction and you will naturally drive up the dike towards Achthoven. After two kilometers, you will reach your destination.
